Small hanging shelf instructions.

- 1. Take your piece of wood and mark out the component parts of the shelf as shown on the adjacent plan.
- 2. Carefully cut out each part using a Hand Saw. Use a Coping Saw for the curves.
- When all the components have been cut out, sand them down with some sand paper to remove any rough surfaces and edges.
- 4. On the back plate mark out the shelf fixing holes using the measurements given on the diagram opposite. Then drill the holes using a 2mm drill bit.
- 5. Using a countersunk drill bit, countersink the shelf fixing holes on the back of the Back Plate only.
- 6. Now fix the Brass Wall hanging plate in the centre of the back plate with the small screw provided.
- 7. 2mm holes should be drilled into the centre of the back edge of the top and bottom shelves.
- 8. Align shelves with back plate and put screws provided into shelves from the back of the back plate to fix in place.
- 9. Paint or varnish your shelf and leave to dry.
